Attendance Matters Every Student. Every Day.

A missed school day is a lost opportunity for students to learn. In this era of increased accountability for states, districts, and schools, the connection between student attendance and learning is being studied more than ever before. It's no secret that students who attend school regularly have been shown to achieve at higher levels than

students who do not have regular attendance. Chronic student absence reduces the teacher's ability to provide learning opportunities and is an issue impacting Stanton School. Our absenteeism rate is far above what the state approves. As a result, we are actively monitoring student attendance and requesting documentation if students are absent due to a medical appointment or are absent for 3 or more consecutive days. Chronic absence is any student who misses 10% or more school days in a year. In District 114, this means any student who misses **17 or more days** for any reason counts as chronic.

The effects of lost school days build up one absence at a time. Any absence, whether excused or not, denies students the opportunity to learn. **We do understand students get sick and emergencies happen.** When this happens please call our Attendance Hotline (847) 973-4200 and press 1 to report an absence. The hotline is open 24/7.




