




8th Grader Wins Art Contest

NJHS Shines Bright for _







Sick Day Guidelines Making the Right Choice


Information provided by the Lake County Health Department.

We ALWAYS want our students in school, but if they are feeling under the weather; please use the following guidelines to help prevent the spread of germs. Keep your child home if they:

- Have a fever of 100.4 or higher
- Have cramps or they are vomiting
- Have a sore throat with fever
- Have a persistent cough
- Have diarrhea
- Have a rash or open draining sores
- Have symptoms that prevent them from participating in school such as excessive tiredness, lack of appetite, headaches, body aches, earaches, or a severe sore throat

Students May Return to School When They:

- Have been feeling good for 24 hours
- Have been fever free without medication for 24 hours
- Have not vomited or had diarrhea for 24 hours
- Have taken the appropriate antibiotic for at least 24 hours
