Dear Stanton Families,

Each year time seems to move more quickly--we can hardly believe the end of the second trimester is right around the corner, and spring break is less than one month away. Spring Break is March 25-29. School resumes on Monday, April 1.

Earlier this week, we kicked off our 2024 Illinois Assessment of Readiness Testing. (IAR) The IAR is Illinois' assessment and accountability measure for Illinois students enrolled in public schools. IAR assesses the Illinois Learning Standards incorporating the Common Core and will be administered in English Language Arts and Mathematics to all students in grades 3-8. The IAR Parent Portal is now available for parents/guardians. The portal provides parents and guardians online access to their child's performance on the IAR test for ELA and Mathematics. The IAR Parent Portal User Guide is available and has information on how to create an account and how to log into the account. The portal will also allow parent/guardians to track their child's scores from year to year, beginning with the spring 2021 results. If more information in IAR and the Parent Portal visit isbe.net/iar.

Friday, March 24 is the last day to order a Stanton yearbook. See page 8 for easy ordering options. Yearbooks are \$20.00 and must be paid for when ordering. Sorry, but no late orders can be taken.



These five indicators that affect and predict school success are:

- Collaborative Teacher
- Involved Families
- Supportive Environment
- Ambitious Instruction
